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Conditions of Rental

1. **Cancellation Policy:** Notices of Cancellation must be received in writing. In the event of cancellation, the following provisions will apply: Cancellations made within 5 business days of signing this application will receive a full refund of all monies paid on the application. However, there will be no refunds of monies for cancellations made after March 11, 2012.
2. **Liability:** The Exhibitor indemnifies and agrees to defend and hold harmless ICE Promotions Society and its directors, officers, employees, agents, advisors and representatives ("indemnified parties") from and against all losses, damages, actions, proceedings, claims, costs, liabilities or expenses (including, without limitation, legal fees on a full indemnity basis) of any kind or nature, whether consisting of direct, indirect, consequential or special losses or damages that have been or may be suffered, sustained or incurred by or brought against any of the indemnified parties as a result of, arising in connection with, or related to the performance or the non-performance of any provision of this agreement or which may be caused by any act or omission of company or its affiliates, employees, agents, servants or invitees.
3. **No Warranty:** Notwithstanding that ICE Promotions Society may be aware of the purposes and objectives of the Exhibitor in using the space; ICE Promotions Society does not warrant that the Exhibitor will be able to achieve any particular result. ICE Promotions Society gives no warranty, express or implied, on the results of the work or the use of the space and any implied warranties or conditions are expressly excluded. ICE Promotions Society, its employees and agents will not be liable for any direct, indirect, special, incidental, consequential, or any other damage suffered by the Exhibitor or others resulting from the access to or use of the Spring Living Fair's Space, the work results, any deliverables or intellectual property developed under this Agreement, including without limitation, damages for lost data or economic loss, regardless of the legal theory (including any negligence theory, except in connection with personal injury or property damage), even if ICE Promotions Society has been advised of the possibility of such damage and even if arising from a fundamental breach.
4. **Relationship:** The relationship of ICE Promotions Society and the Exhibitor under this Agreement is that of independent contractors and nothing in this Agreement will be construed as establishing an agency, partnership, or employment relationship between the parties. Neither party will have the authority to act on behalf of the other party, or to commit the other party in any manner or cause whatsoever or to use the other party's name in any way not specifically authorized by this Agreement. Neither party will be liable for any act, omission, misrepresentation, obligation or debt of the other party, even if informed of such act, omission, representation, obligation or debt, except as specifically authorized by this Agreement.
5. **Damage to Property:** The Exhibitor agrees to be responsible for any damage done to the Space or any other part of Heritage Hall by the Exhibitor, employees, independent contractors, or other agents under the Exhibitor's control. ICE Promotions Society will not assume or accept any responsibility for damage to or loss of any merchandise or articles left in the facility prior to, during, or following the Spring Living Fair. All displays, exhibits, decorations, and signage must be appropriate and in good taste as determined by the Project Manager of the Spring Living Fair.
6. **Cleanup:** The Exhibitor will at all times keep areas occupied by them free from accumulation of waste materials/rubbish caused by its operations, and at the completion of the Event, Exhibitor will remove all waste materials and rubbish and any other materials associated with the event.
7. **Insurance:** The Exhibitor will obtain and maintain in full force and effect at all times during the course of this Agreement sufficient and adequate insurance coverage including, without limitation, the following types of insurance coverage and in the amounts specified:
 - Commercial general liability (including employer's liability, premises/operations, independent Company's, completed operations, products, contractual liability with cross liability endorsement, personal injury, broad form property damage, fire legal liability, and employees as additional insureds. Minimum limit of such coverage: \$1,000,000 combined single limit, per occurrence.
 - Workers' Compensation (as required by applicable law).
 - Umbrella excess liability. Minimum limit: \$2,000,000 per occurrence, excess of all liability coverage's required above.

If requested by ICE Promotions Society, the Exhibitor will provide certificates of insurance, together with originally signed policy endorsements (if applicable) showing that the Exhibitor has obtained at the Exhibitor's own expense the insurance coverage described above.

All such insurance policies will cover all activities of the Exhibitor, space occupied by the Exhibitor, as well as all products and materials supplied by the Exhibitor and all services or operations performed for or on behalf of ICE PROMOTIONS SOCIETY.

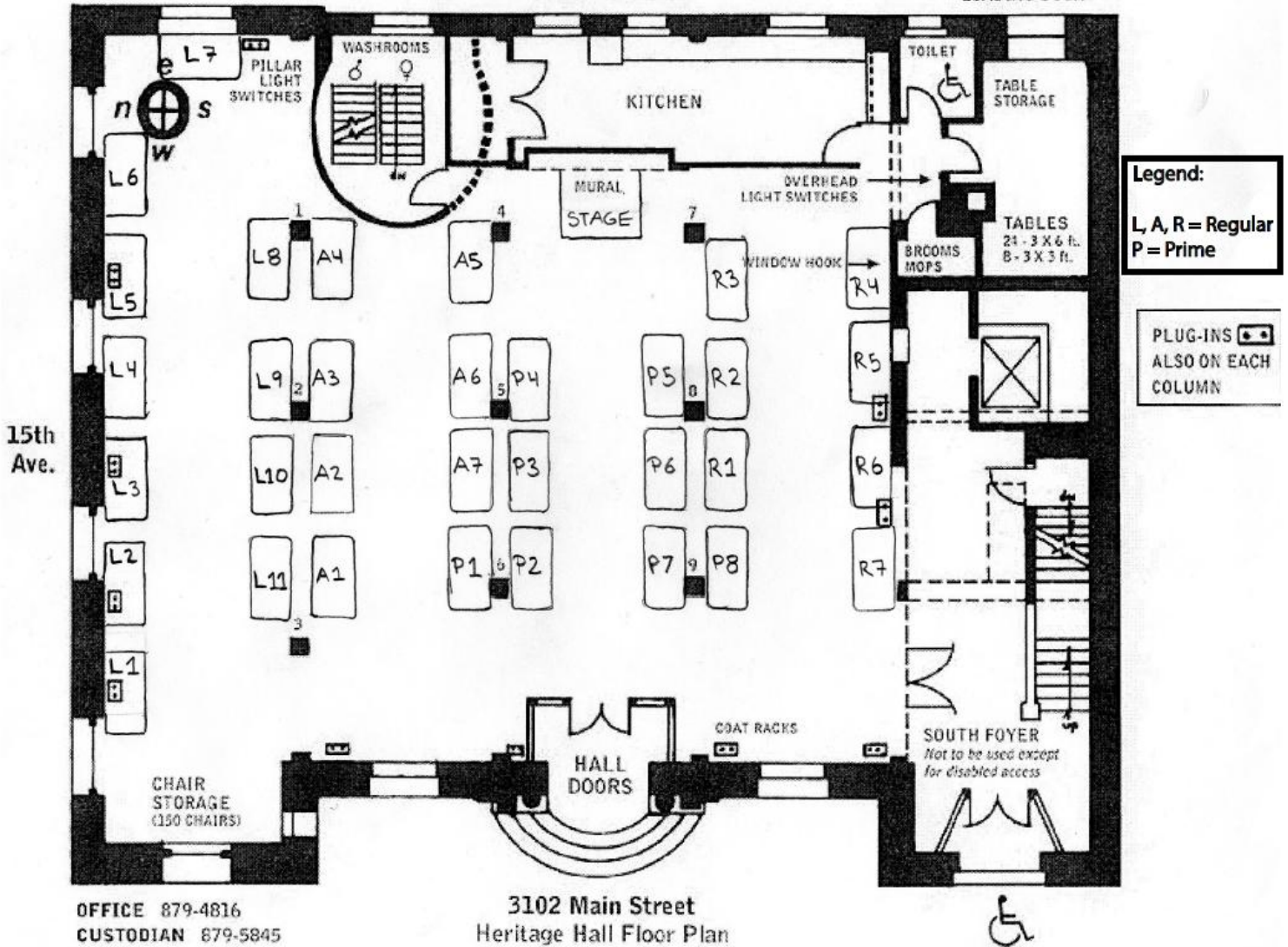
